Support for information security work

The website www.informationssakerhet.se offers a collaboration of most support material that can be needed for working with information security in a systematic manner in organisations.



The support material that is produced and published on www.informationssakerhet.se is based on the standards for information security management system (ISMS). Standards often describe what to do but not how to do it. The ambition of the website is to provide practical and tangible guidance via products with a wide range of application.

The website doesn't just publish completed products. It is just as important to benefit from knowledge and experience gained from practical information security work. Anyone who is interested can follow and participate in the work on producing support by submitting opinions on documents while they are being produced.

Work process

Instead of everyone on their own producing a huge amount of documentation one can in this way combine common efforts. Work will be described in a process map where models, methods, guidelines, support for purchasing, product requirements, and other information material can be inter-connected. This can include support for choosing protection, models and methods for risk management, and support for how to analyse one's own operations and so on.


The Svisa project (Support for information security work) initiated by the MSB, offers a common platform for authorities and organisations working in the field of information security to work together to achieve set goals.

Process map

The introduction of the information security management system (ISMS) includes the following sub-processes, which are grouped in accordance with the internationally recognised PDCA flow chart (Plan, Do, Check, Act). Each of the sub-processes contains specific activities that have to be completed before moving on to the next sub-process. On www.informationssakerhet.se there is an image of the processes and activities described in a flowchart in the following manner:



Clicking on any box in the flowchart opens up a document that describes just that activity.

Apart from the database of documents in the flow chart, the website also contains links to publications from other authorities in this field, and compilations of, for example, legislative codes and standards.

The work on producing content for the website is conducted in cooperation with a number of other authorities and organisations. The MSB is responsible for the long-term administration of the website and its contents.
